Health Career Enrichment Camp

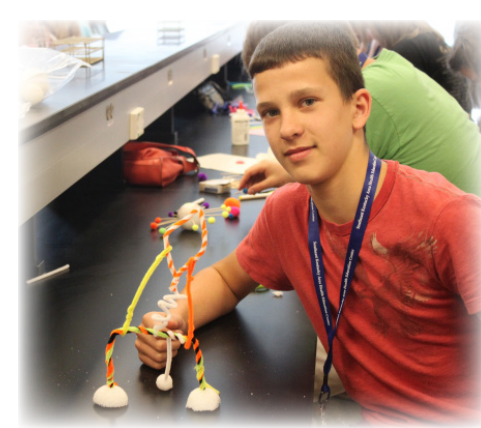
The UK Center for Excellence in Rural Health (UKCERH) and the Southeast Kentucky Area Health Education Center (AHEC) in conjunction with Southeast Kentucky Community & Technical College and UK College of Medicine will be hosting a Health Career Summer Enrichment Camp to be held at the UKCERH in Hazard.

Our mission is to provide a unique learning opportunity to motivate, encourage, and spark an interest in a student to further their education and pursue a career in the ever-growing and advancing field of healthcare.

The camp will introduce incoming freshman and sophomore high school students to a variety of health careers. Students will have the opportunity to observe and shadow healthcare professionals at work; participate in a variety of hands-on activities, tour the University of Kentucky Campus; visit the UKCERH Gross Anatomy Lab; and participate in numerous education opportunities which will better prepare them for a healthcare career.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be a current 8th or 9th grade student from Breathitt, Perry, Leslie, Letcher, Knott, or Harlan County with a genuine interest in pursuing a career in healthcare. In addition, applicants must have a minimum of a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale. Due to the nature of the camp, those applicants who are accepted into the summer camp will be required to undergo a TB Skin Test.

Application Process

The Health Career Enrichment Camp is a selective admission program. Space is limited. Interested students must complete the Application and submit a one-page typed essay describing their interest in healthcare careers, including what career they would like to pursue, and why. Students must also submit two Recommendation Forms from either a school teacher, guidance counselor, or principal.

All applicant's documents must be postmarked by April 7, 2017 to the local Southeast KY AHEC Office.
