

## Student Ambassador Contract

### Academic Year 2018-19

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The following serves as the set of expectations for students invited to participate in the CERH program. A student may be asked to leave the Ambassador program upon the discovery of expectations unfulfilled. It should also be noted that failure to fulfill expectations may hinder an Ambassador from reselection for future academic years.

For their service to the college, Ambassadors shall receive \$500 per academic year pending satisfactory completion of expectations through a 12 point system. The year compensation shall be applied in the form of a scholarship at the end of the year of service. Failure to complete expectations shall result in no compensation for the following year of service and may result in dismissal from the position (and therefore no compensation) for future terms.

### General

*CERH Student Ambassadors must:*

- Be team players
- Be highly motivated, energetic and knowledgeable about the CERH and the University of Kentucky
- Be able to demonstrate leadership skills
- Be able to commit to at least one (academic) year of service.
- Be enrolled in a formal program in the CERH (undergraduate, graduate, or professional)
- Maintain a minimum 3.2 cumulative GPA
- Attend the majority of Ambassador-planned events, or as needed, and must attend all specified college events (further listed)
- Participate in faculty/staff college committees (as requested)

### Expectations and Point System

*All CERH Ambassadors must commit to participation/facilitation of the following events. Successful participation in events shall yield a specific number of points. Ambassadors must attain a sum of 12 points per year to be eligible for compensation and remain in good standing.*

1. Orientation and Team-Building Retreat (TBA) – **Mandatory** (no points awarded)
2. Attend regular weekly or Bi weekly meetings (TBD) – **Mandatory** (no points awarded)

4. No less than two (1) college recruitment events per semester:
  - a. UK CERH Transfer DAY – 1 point
  - b. AHEC events (as announced) – 1 points
  - c. College fairs/Recruiting events (as announced) – 1-2 points
  - d. CERH events/preparation – 1 point
5. Selected program informational sessions for prospective students – 1 point
6. Annual Scholarships & Award Dinner (March or April TBA) – **Mandatory** (no points awarded)
7. National PT Month (October TBA) – 1 -2 point (per event)
8. National Medical Laboratory Professional Week (March TBA) – 1-2 points
9. Social Work Month- (TBA) - 1-2 points
10. Day of Belonging at CERH- 1 point
11. Any other event assigned given appropriate notice (i.e., development and alumni related activities, other) – Point value provided as opportunity is announced.

***I understand and agree to the expectations presented here. I further understand that failure to fulfill expectations may result in my requested departure or prevent me from future reselection as an Ambassador.***
