- Sick visits - ex. sore throat, fever, headache, upper respiratory infections, asthma

- Strep
- Mono
- Urine Dips
- Blood draws when necessary



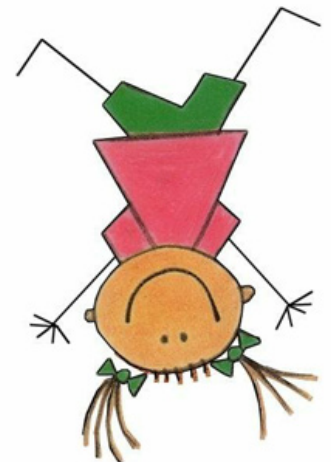
The process

- Forms sent home at the beginning of the year and that include the following
 - Consent to treat (covers full year)
 - HIPAA
 - Flu Vaccine Consent
 - Telemedicine Consent



Process

- Forms completed and returned to main office
- Share list of participating students with schools
- School/parents call access center
- Doc Halo messaging

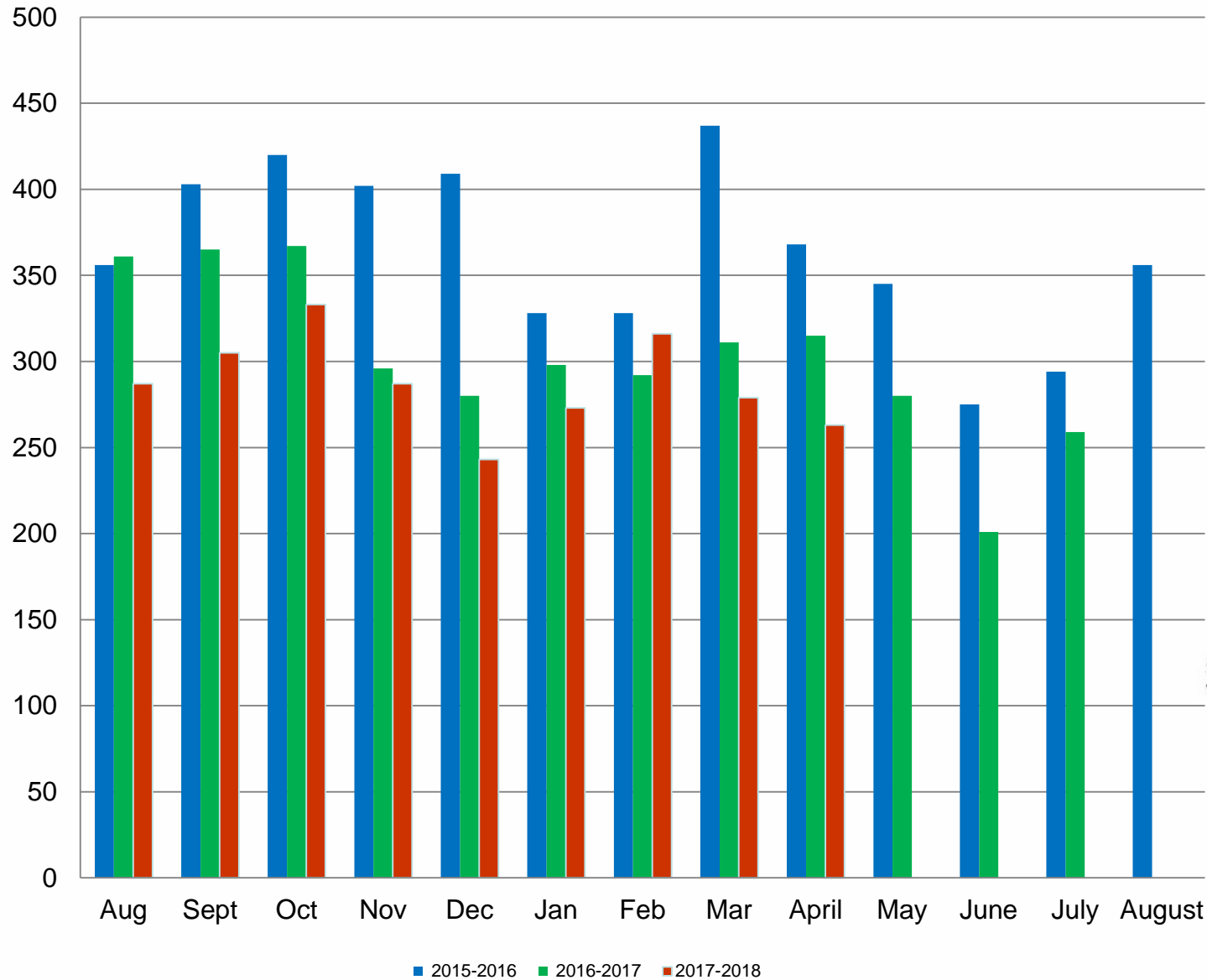


Data

- 63% chose to participate
- 1,566 flu vaccines administered
- 1,667 Hepatitis A vaccines given last month
- 5,384 visits FY18
- 402 telehealth visits
- School district has not canceled for sickness in 2 years
